| 9 | Bolla Sangiovese di Romagna, 2005/6 Italy (B) Intense grapey aroma of raspberry, plum and violet, whilst on the palate the wine blends intense grapeiness with spice and refreshing acidity. | 12.5% | £13.95 |
| 10 | Châteauneuf-du-Pape Cuvée Tradition, Caves Saint-Pierre 2006/7 France (D) Traditions ensure heady aromas of spices and a long velvet character laden with warm fruit cake flavours. | 13.5% | £23.95 |

| 16 Sancerre Les Collinettes, Joseph Mellot, 2007/8 France (1) Stylish and crisp aromas of gooseberries and powerful fruit flavours, linked with a clean finish, from one of the finest and most dynamic producers. | 12.5% | £18.95 |
| 17 Pinot Grigio Provincia di Pavia, Collezione Marchesini, 2006/7 Italy (2) Selected from the south of Lombardy, this lovely buttery style is enhanced by ripe pear flavours. | 12% | £14.95 |
